

Viewing a Course Syllabus in EagleLMS (Moodle)

1. Log into EagleOnline (<https://eagleonline.statetechmo.edu/ics>)
2. Click on the “EagleLMS – My Moodle Courses” page on the “Home” tab and click on the course.
3. After the course opens in a pop-up window, click on the “Syllabus” link.
